

CANTINE POLIDORI SINCE 1938

Set in a charming landscape of valleys and hills, the **Colle del Sole Farm** tells the story of a family that has believed in organic farming and wine-making and the recovery of Umbrian vine varieties: the Polidori's.

Established in 1938 by Nello Polidori, the farm has grown under the leadership of his son Carlo, who led the transition towards organic production. Pesticides, herbicides and chemical fertilizers have not been used for over thirty years, in full respect for nature.

Carlo's daughter, Laretta, has been leading the company since 1999, through a patient work of interpretation and reconversion of ancient wine production practices in light of the newest enological techniques.



About 60% of our 23 hectares of vineyards is cultivated with black grapes (Sangiovese, Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Ciliegiole and Pinot Grigio); the remaining 40% is cultivated with white grapes (Trebiano Toscano, Chardonnay, Grechetto, Verdello, Malvasia and Incrocio Manzoni).

International varieties are grown alongside native ones, in compliance with organic requirements.

HOLIDAY FARMHOUSE

In addition to wines, the farm offers its guests an 11 beds apartment. The farmhouse, which is surrounded by vineyards and centuries-old olive tree groves, is situated in an area characterized by medieval castles and monasteries that testify a rich and fascinating history.

Hunting is forbidden in the area, so you will likely meet buzzards, hawks, pheasants, hares, foxes, porcupines, squirrels or deer while taking a walk.
